#### I. Updates from Officers

- a. Nancy Crecelius reported that she has processed the First Colony SCM Meet to Top Ten and is in the process of completing the Jesse Coon top ten times.
- b. Scott Campbell reported that 125 people have already registered for their 2008 USMS card. We also have 10 teams that have registered for 2008 and are awaiting a few more teams.
- c. Mark Hahn reported spending just under \$3,000 to send representatives to the USMS National Convention. We have also spent \$500 for a SMOG grant and \$250 for the Sally Lowe Memorial.
- d. Kris Wingenroth reported that Rice Masters has requested sanctioning for their SCY meet on March 8<sup>th</sup>. The Gulf is still looking for an observer for the Senior Olympic Meet in College Station on April 18<sup>th</sup>. The Houston Senior Olympic Meet has not asked to be a recognized meet.

#### II. 2008 Calendar Updates

- a. January 1<sup>st</sup> First Colony will be hosting a New Years Day Practice for any 2008 Registered USMS Swimmer. The workout is planned at the Ft. Bend Aquatic Center at 10:30 AM. Everyone is invited to go out to lunch after the workout.
- b. January 26<sup>th</sup> The Woodlands is holding a swim clinic with Olympic Medalist and World Record Holder Shane Gould. The clinic will include pool session, lecture and swim specific dry land. The Clinic is limited to the first 40 people to register at a cost of \$40 a person. The clinic runs from 2-4 on Saturday January 26<sup>th</sup>.
- c. There is a proposal from First Colony to host a swim clinic in April
- d. There is a proposal from First Colony to host a LCM swim meet June 28<sup>th</sup> or 29<sup>th</sup>.

#### III. Fitness Challenge

- a. As a motivator for 2008, the Gulf LMSC is offering a free Fitness Challenge to all Registered Gulf swimmers.
  - i. Our goal is two fold- First we would like as many swimmers as possible to participate in a 3 Month challenge that challenges them

to swim more than they do right now. Secondly, we want to encourage swimmers to aim for a goal of swimming at SCY Nationals in Austin on May 1-4<sup>th</sup>.

- b. Stacey Van Horn will be distributing a form in the next two weeks to all Gulf Representatives. This form will have the swimmer record, day and amount of time swum during the 3 month challenge. When the challenge ends T-Shirts will be given to swimmers who reach predetermined time goals ( 40, 60, or 80 hours).

#### IV. Website

- a. Sheila is working with Club Assistant to bring up our new Gulf Website sometime in January. We are starting with 4 PDF's including facilities, announcements, calendar, and registration. She was also given \$400 to buy Dreamweaver since her old version has crashed.

#### V. Jesse Coon Award

- a. We are asking Jill to send an email to all South Central Zone reps. We are asking each SC LMSC to give a name for the Jesse Coon award. We are also asking that a committee be made from a rep from each South Central Zone LMSC. The Jesse Coon Committee will thus have 6 reps plus a standing rep of Judy Wagner on the committee. We are tasking the committee to come up with an award recipient.
